

# Colin the Coastguard

## Dress-Up as Colin or Shelley

### You will need:

- baseball cap
- shirt/blouse/polo shirt or T-shirt
- trousers
- belt for trousers
- wellington boots
- 2 A4 sheets red paper, or white paper to colour in
- colour print of C logos, yellow epaulettes and wellington topper template on next page
- scissors and methods to attach paper to garments eg double-sided tape/glue dots/sticky tack/tacked stitches etc\*



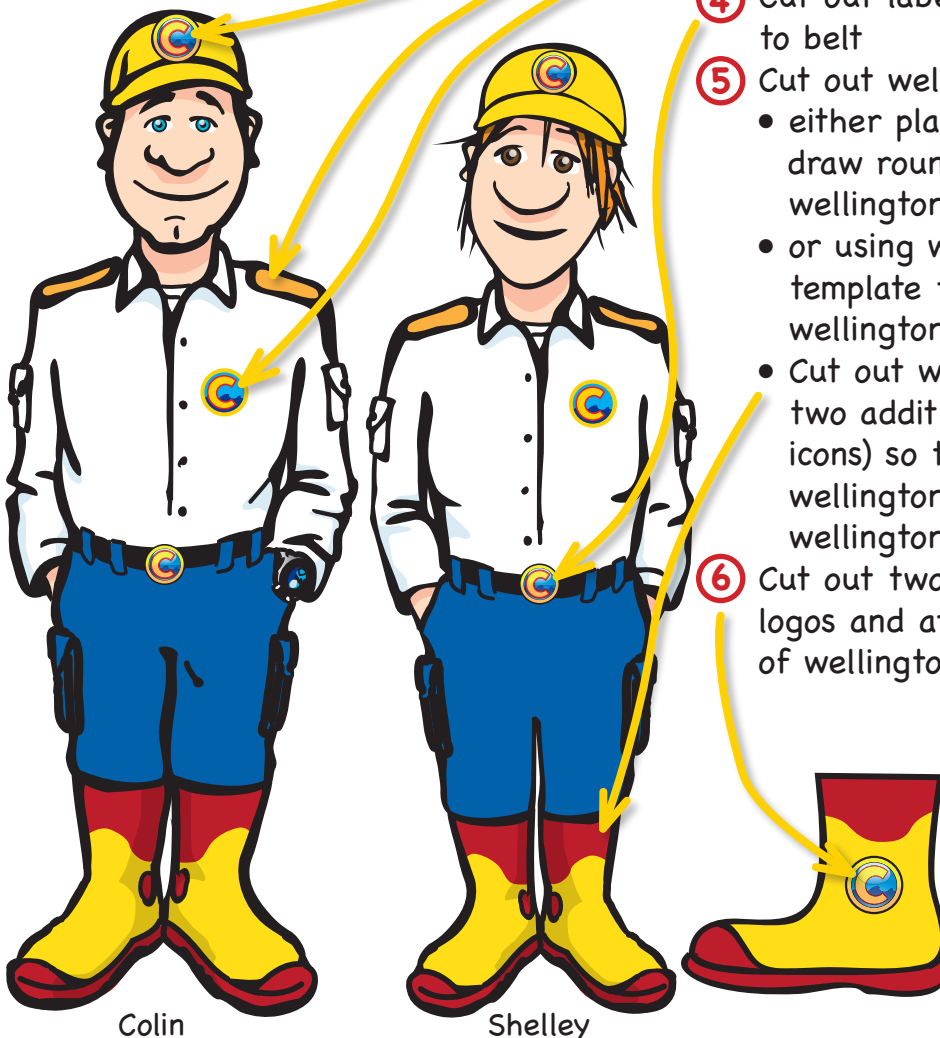
Be careful –

### Instructions:

- 1 Cut out labelled C logo and attach to baseball cap
- 2 Cut out epaulettes and attach to shoulders of shirt
- 3 Cut out labelled C logo and attach to shirt
- 4 Cut out labelled C logo and attach to belt
- 5 Cut out wellington topper template
  - either place on red paper and draw round twice to create two wellington toppers
  - or using white paper, draw round template twice and colour in both wellington toppers red
  - Cut out wellington toppers; make two additional cuts (see scissor icons) so they fold over the wellington boots easily; attach to wellingtons, from front to back
- 6 Cut out two labelled small C logos and attach to outer side of wellingtons
